NEW BILL AMENDING THE SELF-CLEANING RULES

On 9 July 2019, the Danish Competition and Consumer Authority published for consultation a Bill amending the Danish Public Procurement Act. In this newsletter we will look at the Bill and its importance.

Correct and sufficient documentation of the information contained in an ESPD is essential to the contracting entity in connection with EU procurements. The Competition and Consumer Authority has just released an updated version of their memo on ESPD documentation, including latest practice.

MATERIAL RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS ARE SUBJECT TO APPROVAL AND DISCLOSURE

On 10 June 2019 the rules in the Danish Companies Act on approval and disclosure of transactions between a listed company and its related parties came into effect. The rules intend to ensure sufficient transparency for shareholders of listed companies, and that transactions with related parties are concluded on normal market terms.

BREXIT: MAIN TAKE-AWAYS FROM THE DANISH GOVERNMENT'S BREXIT PRESS CONFERENCE

On 18 September 2019 the Danish Government held a press conference where the ministers of taxation, foreign affairs and trade presented which initiatives were or would be undertaken to prepare Denmark for a no-deal Brexit on 31 October 2019.
